Parking Lots Drive, park and walk safely in parking lots

Drive in traffic lanes.

Do not drive through vacant parking spaces.

Watch for small vehicles entering traffic lanes parked beside larger cars and trucks.

Be prepared to stop for vehicles with backup lights on or engines running.

Always watch out for pedestrians walking with their backs to you, they cannot see you.

Vehicle Parking Safety



Park your vehicle so to drive out to enter the traffic lane.

Vehicle operators can readily see approaching vehicles and pedestrians when driving out of a parking space.

Don't back out of a parking space if possible.

Drivers must carefully check their surroundings before backing and while backing in a parking lot.

Parking spaces reserved for persons with disabilities are only for those with disabilities.

Always use a crosswalk.

Vehicles must to yield to pedestrians in a crosswalk.

Walk adjacent to parked vehicles and check each vehicle before walking behind it.

Be sure the driver of a vehicle sees you before walking in front of or behind a vehicle with its engine running or its backup lights are on.
