The Town of Glenville, in partnership with County Waste, announces the town-wide bulk waste pick-up for all

residents of the Town of Glenville, and outside the Village of Scotia. The trucks will be collecting by zone. Zone 1

will begin March 23, 2020. Zone 2 will begin March 30, 2020. Zone 3 will begin April 6, 2020. Residents are

asked to be patient with the collection process. Metal (including approved appliances) must be placed in a

separate pile from the items below. Metal items such as pipes etc. can be no longer than 6'.
