



# TOWN OF GLENVILLE & TWIN BRIDGES



The Town of Glenville, in partnership with Twin Bridges, announces a town-wide refuse collection program for all residents of the Town of Glenville, outside of the Village of Scotia. Containers will be placed at the Town of Glenville complex at 18 Glenridge Rd Glenville NY 12302 on Saturday, July 15th and Saturday, July 22nd from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. Residents participating in the program should remain in their vehicles and follow the direction of on-site personnel. Only one vehicle at a time will be allowed to dispose of waste into the containers unless directed otherwise. The Town will verify residency for participants.

Acceptable metal items will be disposed of separately.

**IMPORTANT: Household cleanout does not include demolition debris from home improvement projects. This event is for large items only. If it will fit in your trash can DO NOT bring it to this event. Bagged or loose trash will not be accepted.**

## Acceptable

Furniture: Sofa, loveseats, recliners, tables, chairs, mattresses, box springs, rugs/carpets, patio furniture

Fixtures: Sinks, toilets, cabinets, doors and screens

Metal: Appliances, washers, dryers, hot water tanks, stoves, dishwashers, grills, doors, pipes, fencing, lawn mowers (no gas or oil), automotive parts

## Not Acceptable

Appliances: Refrigerators, freezers, & air conditioners, or any other item containing freon

Fixtures: Glass doors, windows, tubs & hot tubs

Miscellaneous: Riding mowers, televisions, computers, electronic waste, fluorescent bulbs, motor oil, tree stumps, logs, yard waste, tires, paints, stains, sealers, hazardous chemicals, aerosol cans, gas cans, propane tanks, decks, boats, woodsheds, demolition material
