In order to protect ourselves during winter storms, it is necessary to understand the way that these storms may affect us!





Impact on Infrastructure

The buildup of snow can cause:

- The collapse of roofs
- Falling trees and power lines
- Pipes that freeze and burst

These issues can result in heavy damage to homes and the loss of power for days

Health Impacts

- Cold temperatures may cause frostbite, which is the freezing of your skin and the tissue below it
- Cold temperatures can also cause hypothermia, an extremely low body temperature
- Overexertion when shoveling snow can lead to heart attacks

Impacts to Roads

- Heavy snow & winds can make it difficult to see, which can increase the likelihood of a car accident
- Slippery road conditions can also cause more accidents
- Storms can slow the delivery of mail & supplies
- They can also slow the response time of medical and emergency services
- Unsafe driving conditions can prevent people from travelling to work, school, and other places
