What are Porous pavers?

- A Porous paver is a cellular grid system that is filled with either dirt, sand, or gravel. The Porous pavers provide grass reinforcement, ground stabilization and gravel retention. The pavers are able to transfer vertical heavy loads from the surface and distribute them over a wide area of space.



Where are Porous Pavers found?

- Grass areas
- Driveways

- The Porous pavers are important because they are able to help distribute weight across the whole ground. The Porous pavers are also able to help water sink into the ground more efficiently.
