TOWN TO HOST TREE PLANTING CEREMONY TO MARK EARTH DAY

Dogwood trees to be added to town's dog park

Glenville, N.Y. – Officials from the town will be joined by local business leaders to plant trees in the Andersen Park where the town's dog park is located at 180 Van Buren Rd on Saturday, April 21st.

Lilananda Yoga studio (585 Saratoga Road) will be on hand to help plant the trees and will offer residents free yoga classes on Sunday, April 22. The event on Sunday runs from Noon to 4 PM and offers free yoga classes from 1:15-3:45. Each class will focus on an element of nature; earth, water, wind and fire. Lilananda Yoga will also give-a-way free plant root clippings and have a book swap table.

The BioSoil Farm of the Glenville Business and Technology Park has also donated the "super-charged potting soil" made from worm castings at the Glenville indoor farm. Representatives from the farm will be on-hand to talk about their environmentally friendly soil mixtures.

The trees were purchased from Hewitt's Garden Center in Glenville.

The Saturday tree planting will be held at 9:30 AM.

"The town is pleased to have such great members of our business community come together and help us beautify our park while celebrating Earth Day," said Chris Koetzle, Town Supervisor. "This tree planting, although small in context, highlights the need to better protect our planet and acts to remind our residents that collectively, we can all do something to be better stewards."
