BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Clerk be and she hereby is authorized and directed to issue the required permit subject to any stipulations cited by the Chief of Police, the Schenectady County Health Department and the East Glenville Fire Department.

Discussion...

Earl Redding, Attorney for the Town – “Recently there became an emergency at Instantwhip. It appears that their septic system malfunctioned and a request was made by Superintendent Coppola to have Instantwhip and their location at 27 Maple Avenue added to Sewer District No. 9. We require a public hearing and based upon the fact we had a special meeting here tonight we added this on the agenda. The resolution is based upon a petition that was brought in today by the owner of Instantwhip. The map, plan and report has been previously filed in the office of the Town Clerk pursuant to Town Law 193. The Board needs a public hearing to have this location added to the sewer district.

RESOLUTION NO. 117-2020

WHEREAS, a written petition has been presented to and filed with the Town Clerk of the Town of Glenville requesting an extension to Sewer District No. 9 of the Town of Glenville be established to include real property described by section, block and lot number in the petition and consisting of one parcel located at 27 Maple Avenue in the Town of Glenville; and

WHEREAS, a map, plan and report was previously filed in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Glenville with respect to the Extension to Sewer District No. 9 down Maple Avenue which anticipated lateral connections such as the one now proposed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that pursuant to the provisions of Town Law §193, the Town Board of the Town of Glenville hereby adopts the following order:

ORDER

1. A petition to add an Extension to Sewer District No. 9 from an existing lateral in Maple Avenue has been filed with the Town Clerk on or about June 03, 2020.
2. The real property to be included in the extension is described by section, block and lot number as identified on the Schenectady County Real Property Tax Service Agency Tax Map as: 30.-1-15.
3. The improvements proposed are the connection of a lateral connection to the main of approximately 45 feet for one individual service connection at 27 Maple Avenue.
4. The amount proposed to be expended for the extension is approximately \$ 4,000.00 to be borne entirely by the property owner/developer.
5. No portion of the cost this extension will be attributable to Sewer District No. 9.
6. The estimated annual cost to the typical property is:
 - a. District debt service: \$168.37
 - b. O & M: \$211.62
7. The prior map, plan and report describing the extension of Sewer District No. 9 down Maple Avenue is on file in the Town Clerk’s Office and may be inspected by members of the public.

8. The proposed financing method to be employed in the construction of this connection in this sewer district extension is private financing by the developer.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Glenville will hold a public hearing on the petition to establish this extension to Sewer District No. 9 on June 17, 2020 at 7:00 PM or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached, at the Glenville Municipal Center at 18 Glenridge Road, Glenville, New York to hear all persons interested in the establishment of this extension to the sewer district; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this order certified by the Town Clerk shall be published at least once in the official newspaper of the Town and that said publication be not less than ten nor more than twenty days before the June 17, 2020 public hearing date.
